

Care of the Covid-19 Patient PPE Guidelines

Important Reminders

PPE Do's and Don'ts

- Don't leave PPE in the patients home - gloves, gown, mask, face shield, shoe covers and head covers.
- Do don respiratory protection outside of the home whenever possible.
- Do don and doff PPE closest to the patients door as possible.
- Don't bring extra items into the home ONLY the items you need to take care of the patient.
- Don't bring single used PPE out of the home.

The following items are to be kept in the home after the initial visit.

Thermometer *

Stethoscope*

Sphygmomanometer*

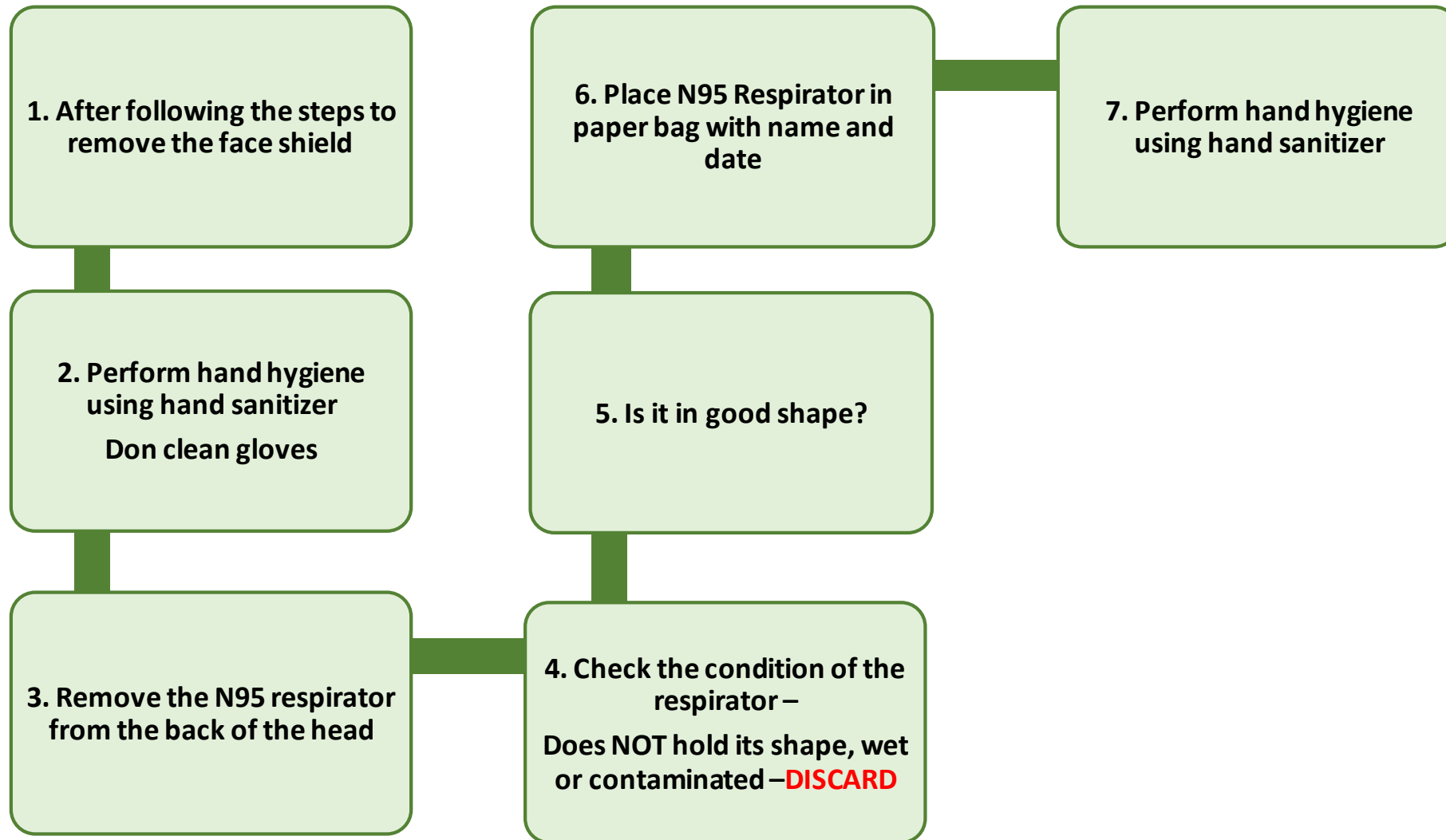
Pulse Oximeter* (where available)

Protocol for the Limited Reuse and Extended Use of N95 Respirators

LIMITED REUSE

Limited reuse refers to the practice of using the same N95 Respirator for multiple encounters with patients but doffing after each encounter

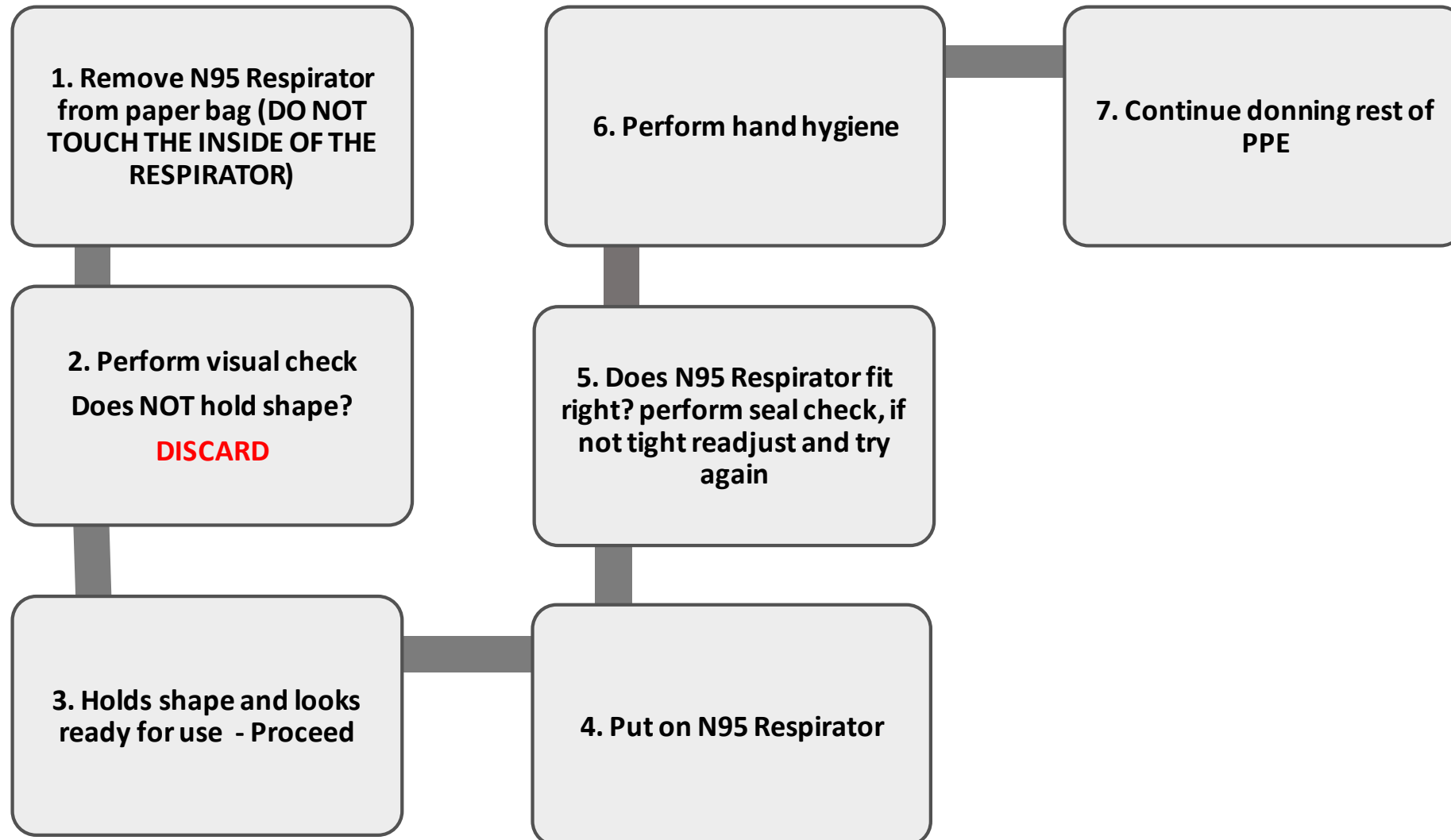


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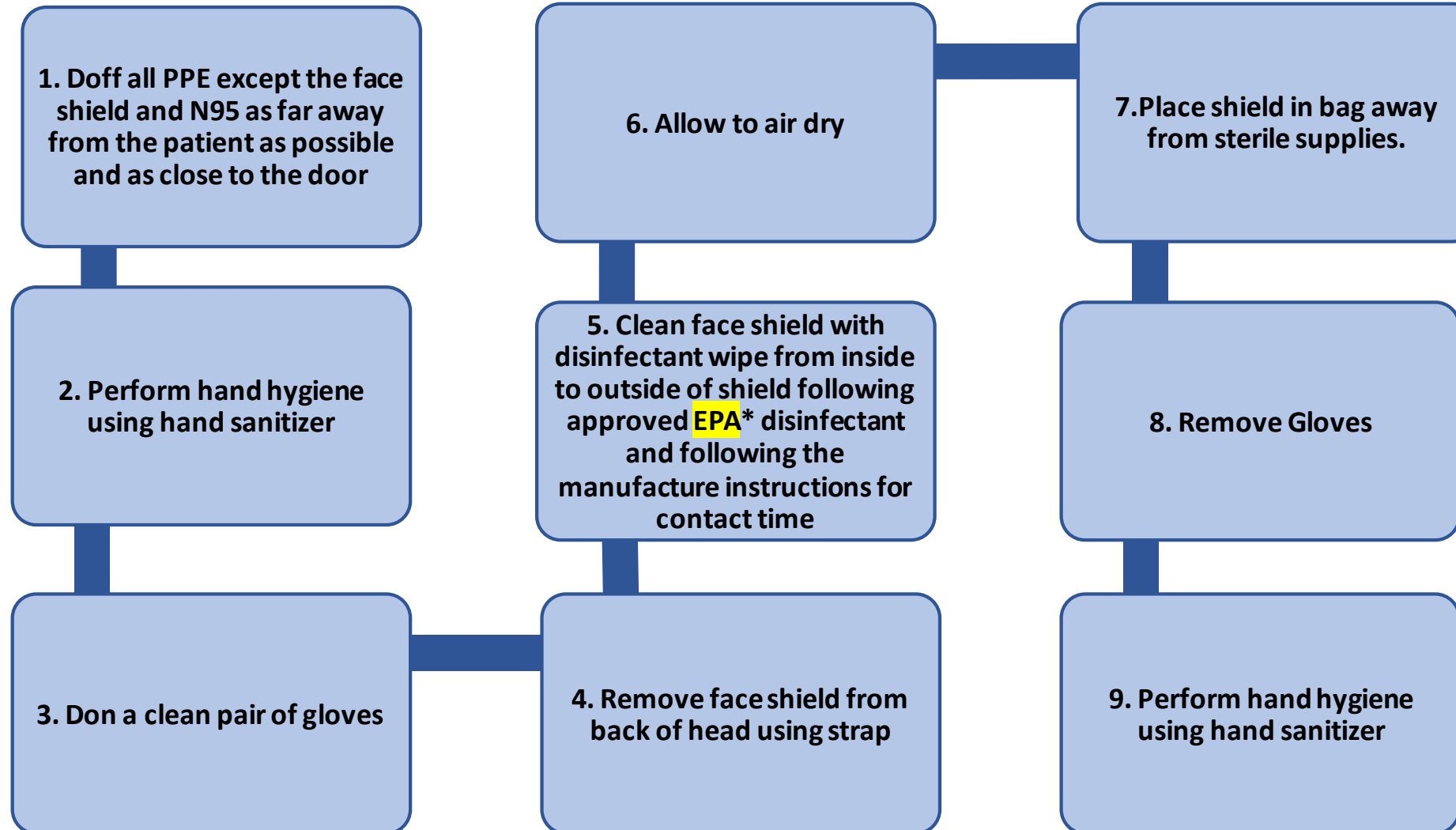


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Protocol for the Limited Reuse and Extended Use of Face Shield

LIMITED REUSE

Limited reuse refers to the practice of using the same face shield for multiple encounters with patients but doffing after each encounter



* 70% Alcohol Wipes, EPA approved disinfectant such as – Clorox Wipes/Lysol disinfectant wipes.

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
